





















PIR HENRY'S BATHROOM REPRESENTS THE HEIGHT OF MODERNITY, CIRCA 1912. HEIGHT OF MODERN IT IS FULLY EQUIPPED WITH A MODERN SHOWER THAT FEATURES SIX BODYSPRAYS, CONTROLLED BY SEPARATE FAUCETS. THE WALLS AND FLOORS ARE TILED WITH DECORATIVE ITALIAN MARBLE, SYMBOLIZING WEALTH BUT ALSO FOR HYGIENIC PURPOSES. IN PELLATT'S TIME, THE VIEW LOOKING OUT THE BATHROOM WINDOW WOULD HAVE OVERLOOKED THE "WARD", WHICH WAS THE SLUM OF TORONTO.
